

Influenza Vaccine

By January 1, 2020 children aged 6-59 months attending a child care center, group or family day care shall receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between July 1 and December 31 of the preceding year.

Interpretation: If your child will be between 6 months and 59 months of age as of January 1, 2020 they are required to receive the Influenza vaccine in any of the 6 months prior (July-December) in order to attend child care. Children who do not receive the flu vaccine by December 31st 2019 must be excluded from child care for the duration of influenza season (January through March 31st) or until they receive at least one dose of the Influenza vaccine.
